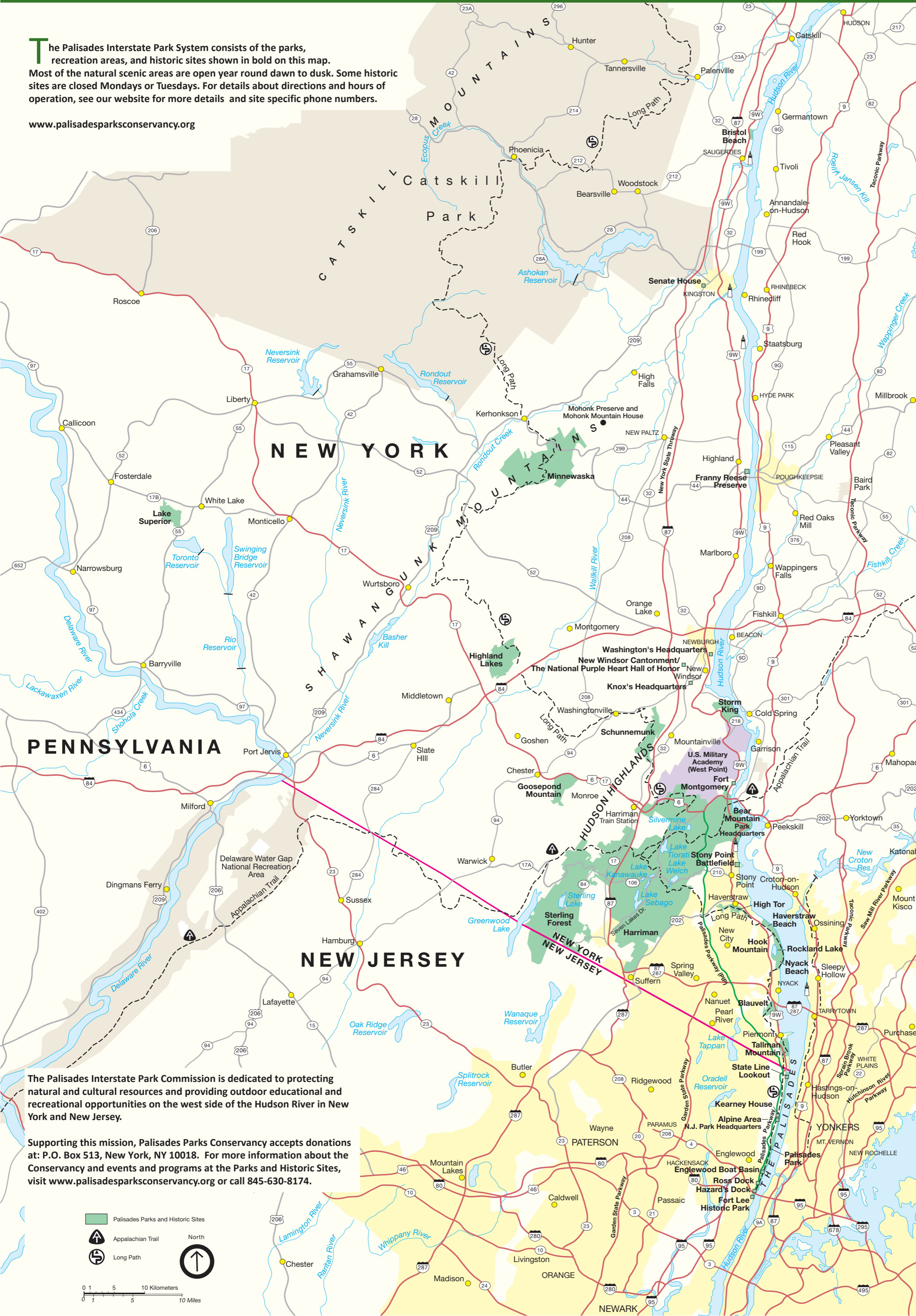


Palisades Parklands and Historic Sites

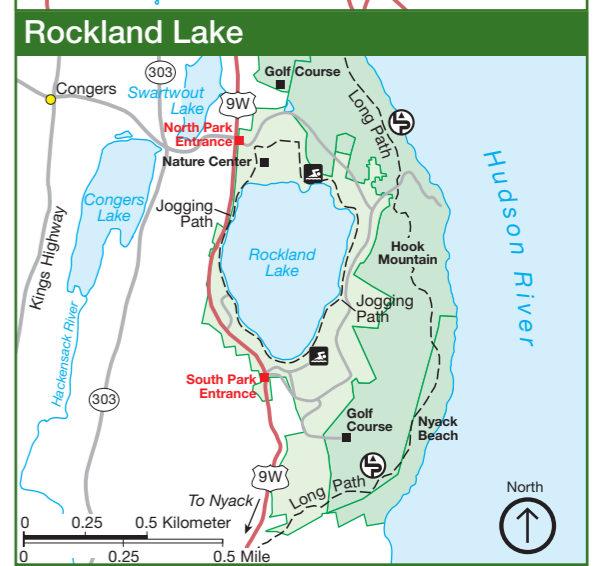
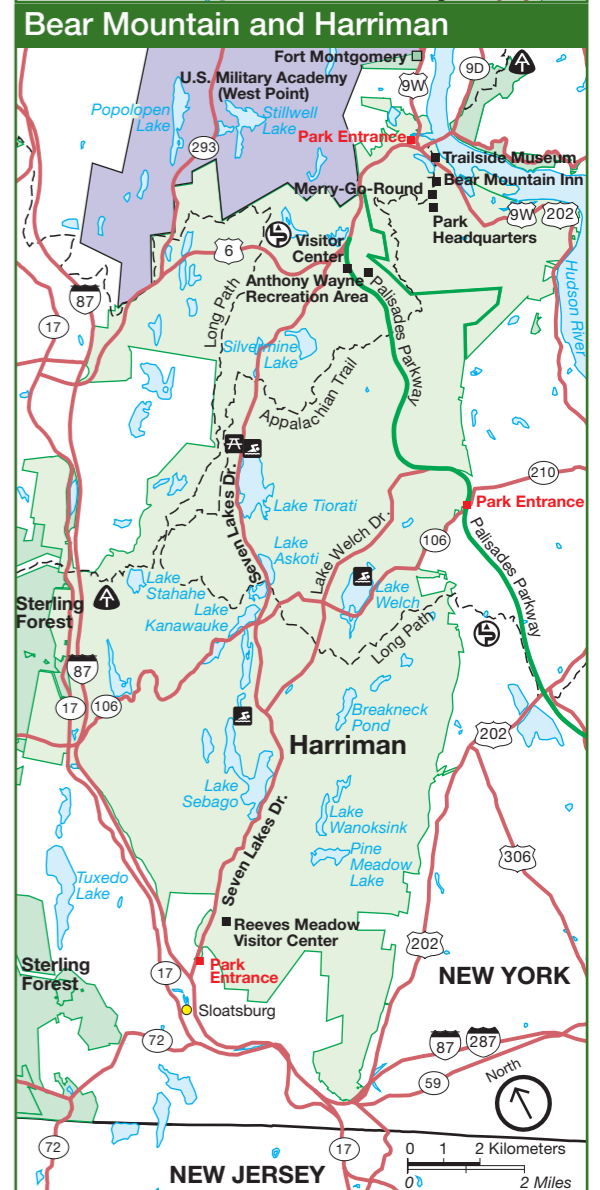
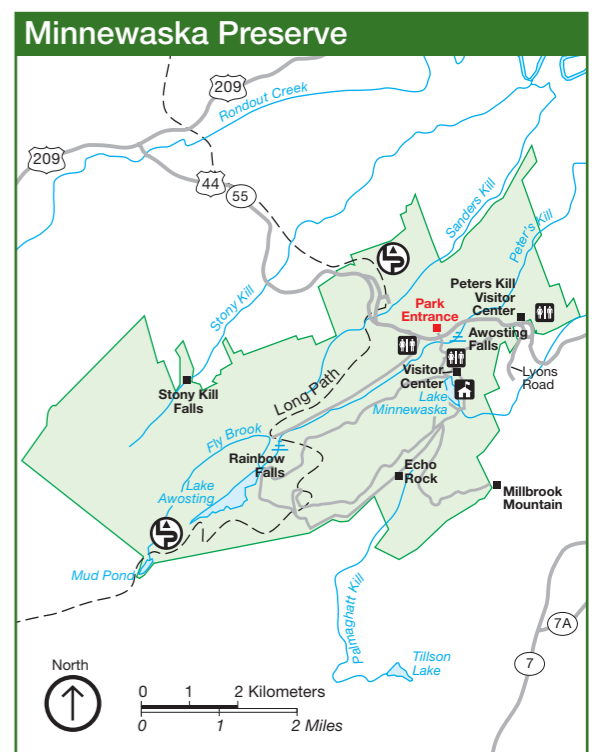
